The project aims to support the needs of the Landcare community to restore the natural environment after the 2019-20 bushfires, with a vision of positive on-ground outcomes in environmental bushfire recovery and community resilience. We can provide support to plant native species, manage weeds, and fencing*.

Revegetation must be native indigenous species local to your specific site, planted in proportion with the correct Ecological Vegetation Community. A team member will support and advise on this.

We are unable to fund projects retrospectively.

All sites will require on-going maintenance, which is the responsibility of the applicant.
